FORMS OF STUDENT DISCIPLINE

- A. **Teacher student:** Teachers may and are encouraged to handle their own detention or other disciplinary measures for misconduct in their classes.
- B. **Social probation:** The denial of a student to attend and/or participate in extra-curricular activities, school dances or any other form of after-school activity.
- C. **Detention:** A student is assigned to a specific supervised room during and/or after school hours.
- D. **Suspensions:** A student is denied attendance at school or school functions for a designated number of days in accordance with the provisions of Policy JGD, Suspension and Expulsion
 - a. Any student who is suspended from school has a right to appeal the decision to the Superintendent. The appeal process will be explained by the Superintendent at that time.
 - b. A student is not permitted on school property at any time during the duration of an out-of-school suspension.
- E. **Expulsion:** Expulsion will be made only by School Board (see JGD).
