It is that time of year for students not earning credits in one or more classes at Spaulding High School to consider enrolling in summer school. Spaulding High School's summer school is aimed at helping students get back on track earning credits towards graduation and improve student achievement. At this time we would like to invite your child to participate in summer school to help them reach these goals.

**Summer School Information and Dates to Remember:**

- Students can bring completed registration forms to the Main Office of Spaulding High School.
- Registration has started! The deadline for registration is: **Wednesday June, 27, 2018**
- Summer school mandatory orientation is: **Monday July 9, 2018**
  - **9:00 am- check in begins in the main lobby**
  - **9:30am- report to the auditorium**
  - **12:00- Dismissal**
- Summer school classes in session: **Tuesday July 10, 2018 thru Friday August 3, 2018.**
- **Classes run Monday thru Friday 8am-12pm.**

**Eligibility**

- Summer school is open to students who need to recover credits or complete course competencies.
- Up to two core courses in which a student must have earned an NYC or IWS.
- All summer school registrations require a school counselor signature.
- If a student wishes to complete a Plato course, the student must have a recommendation from the Plato coordinator.
- Please note that summer school is 20 days with the first day being a mandatory orientation. Attendance is required, so please plan vacations/absences around this commitment.

## How to Enroll

- Spaulding High School: We will be accepting registrations until June 27<sup>th</sup>. Registration forms can be picked up in the guidance office. Please turn in your registration form to the main office along with your payment.
- All programs are \$80 per course for Spaulding High School students and \$100 for non-residents. Also, note that there is a reduced price of \$20 per course for SHS students that qualify for free and reduced lunch. Please make checks payable to: **Rochester School District**. Cash is accepted. There will be **NO REFUNDS** after July 13, 2018.
- The deadline for registration is **Wednesday June 27, 2018. Due to the limited staff and extensive prep work that is required, this deadline is firm.**

- **Motivate your child to enroll.** What are your child's goals for the future? Discuss the ways that summer school will help him or her meet these goals.
- **Ensure attendance and punctuality.** You know your child. Some high school students still need you as the alarm clock, while others will do fine without it.
