## **AGE OF ENTRANCE**

Every child between six and eighteen years of age shall attend the public school within the district or a public school outside the district to which he/she is assigned, or an approved private school, during all the time the public schools are in session, unless he/she has been excused from attending on the grounds that his/her physical or mental condition is such as to prevent his/her attendance or to make it undesirable, provided that if a child reaches his/her sixth birthday after September 30 he/she will not be required to attend school under these provisions until the following school year.

Parents of children who reach their sixth birthday after September 30 and before November 30 may request an exception from the minimum age requirement to the Superintendent. A student may enter kindergarten if his/her chronological age will be five before September 30 of the year of entering school.

The Superintendent will consider all relevant information, when considering an exception to the minimum age requirements. The decision of the Superintendent shall be final, and may not be appealed to the School Board.
